### **Splash and Dash Canoe Races (June 23<sup>rd</sup>)**

- The Splash and Dash signs are out.
- Nancy will check with the Boy Scouts to see if they have canoes to rent.
- A map was handed out and the route was determined to be from Lakefront Park to the Dam's property, roughly 2.6 miles round trip.
- West Marine donated a 9-foot kayak for the raffle.
  - A suggestion was made to start the raffle at this event but continue to sell tickets and draw the winner at the Fourth of July Celebration.
- Bud Scott arranged canoes for rent. There will be a \$10 fee to rent the canoe and a driver's license will be required and held for the rental and a waiver must be signed. Rentals are for the time of the event only and are to be returned promptly.
  - The fee needs to be updated on forms and website from \$25 to \$10.
- Canoe race will be held first and then the raft race will follow.
- The air compressor needs to be borrowed from the street department.
- There will be a DJ who will provide the following games: limbo and water balloon toss (need to check on who is to provide the balloons). Additional games include: potato sack races (age ranges: 6-8, 9-11 and 12-15), dunk tank (officials needed to go in tank), knock down the clown, tic tac toe, duck pond and bucket/sponge relay.
- The Fire Department is providing the food and food sales for the event.
- The dash will go towards Jet Fun and the Explorers will direct traffic during the event.
- Booths will be set up from 11-4.
- The Explorers and possibly the Boy Scouts will oversee the games.

- Next year check to see if there are groups (i.e. cheerleaders) who would like to raise money for their organization by getting pledges for the event.
- The pontoon piers need to be installed. Bud Scott will check on the floating pier from Wauconda and Ron at the waterway. Divers need to check 25-50 feet for objects (i.e. hooks).

### **Lotus Bed Tours**

- Day tours are August 6<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. The day tours will include lunch and leave at 11:15am.
- Evening cruises are August 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>. The evening tours will include dinner and leave at 5:45pm.
- All cruises include the boat rental (\$150 per hour unless eating at Blarney's), captain and a guide. The minimum number of passengers for all cruises is 20 passengers and the maximum is 37 passengers. Passengers must be 21 or accompanied by an adult for any cruise. The cost of the cruise is \$12; this covers the \$10 food and leaves \$2 for tips.

### **4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade**

- There will be a 75-piece band called Men in Brass performing.
- Nancy will check with Lee or Kim to see about staging the parade.
- If there are not enough officials to ride on the village float, the centennial committee should ride.

- The two banners are done and awaiting the check.
- The ending place for the parade needs to be verified.
