A U.S. census happens every 10 years and your participation is required by law. A Census form will be delivered to your household between February and March which should be turned in as soon as possible by Census Day, April 1, 2010. Census information affects the numbers of seats our state occupies in the U.S. House of Representatives. It also guides local decision makers in where to locate shopping, restaurants, housing, child care and senior citizen centers and determines state and local funding and services for roads and other public works projects. All information is protected by law and all census bureau employees are sworn for life to protect the confidentiality of the data.

- Social Security numbers
- Telephone numbers
