SWALCO Household Chemical Waste Collections

SWALCO (the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County) announces upcoming **HCW (Household Chemical Waste)** collections for spring/summer. If you are cleaning your basement, garage or shed and have unwanted HCW (Household Chemical Waste) items such as driveway sealer, oil-based paints, pool chemicals, garden and lawn chemicals, old gasoline, or other HCW products, take a look at the collection schedule. Items will be taken care of safely and conveniently. Did you know that SWALCO will also accept unwanted medications and prescriptions? Fluorescent light bulbs/CFLs are also accepted. Please check their website if you have questions regarding items that are accepted at www.swalco.org.

All of SWALCO's Mobile HCW Collections are sponsored by SWALCO. They are for Illinois residents ONLY. There is no charge for residents. You do not need to reside in the community where the collection takes place in order to participate. All mobile events are held on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., unless otherwise noted. Upcoming events include:

- June 6 Lake Zurich Middle School (former North Campus), 66-100 Church Street, Lake Zurich, IL
- July 18 Wauconda High School, 555 N. Main Street, Wauconda, IL
- August 1 Deerfield High School, 1959 N. Waukegan Road, Deerfield, IL

You can also bring your HCW to one of SWALCO's Year-Round Drop-off Events at their Gurnee facility. Register online on the collection events page. Sign up for one of the selected dates and available time slots and you will receive an email confirmation of your appointment. Drop-off events are scheduled multiple times per month, including the second Saturday of each month. Appointment is required. If you do not have access to a computer to schedule online, you can call the SWALCO office and register by phone at 847-336-9340.

A variety of common household materials can be brought to a HCW collection day, including:

Business, institutional and commercial wastes, explosives (such as fireworks and ammunition), propane tanks, smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, agricultural chemicals, medical wastes, household electronics and Latex paint **will not be accepted** at any of the agency's HCW events. Tires and lead acid batteries (auto and boat batteries) are also not accepted at these collections. These items can be recycled at a retail outlet that sells them. For information on what to do with Latex paint, including how to recycle and alternatives to disposal, (Ela Township's recycling program, Earth Paints and more) look on the Latex Paint Disposal page of the SWALCO website.
