

## **Fox Lake Fireworks Meeting Minutes/Notes**

### **Update of Committees:**

#### Review of Proposals

Chief Behan stated the Fireworks Selection Committee met with the different companies, and we have received their quotes. I am distributing a copy of the quotes to each of the selection committee members for consideration and review and then we will schedule a sub-committee meeting for a recommendation to the Village Board.

#### Fundraisers

Chief Behan stated we have distributed the water bottles to the businesses to collect money for the Fireworks. We have distributed 18 bottles, and we will get an additional 10 ready to distribute. Ruth will contact Hinckley Schmitt to request the additional 10 bottles. They are located throughout the Village.

The Golf Outing is set for Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, at Fox Lake County Club. We will have 9 holes in the daytime hours, break for hot dogs/hamburgers etc. and then start the nighttime golf. You can play daytime, or nighttime or both, it is your option. We anticipate a good crowd, this is the first night time golf in Fox Lake and we look forward to the event.
