



**VILLAGE OF FOX LAKE
VILLAGE BOARD MEETING MINUTES
AMENDED AUGUST 14, 2007**

STATE OF ILLINOIS,

At the regular Board Meeting, held in said Village and County in the State of Illinois at 7:00 p.m. on June 26, 2007 meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin. The following official business was transacted:

Roll Call

Present Mayor Irwin; Village Clerk Weeks; Attorney Teegen; Trustees, Bender, Murrey Ulasz, Working, Kiesgen and Koske.

- I. Preliminary Audience Comments – 15 minute limits, 3 minutes per person**
Lisa Bittner – Forest Ave. stated that Hidden Glen was known as living in the ghetto and they were working hard to improve their reputation by spending millions of dollars to improve their property. Ms. Bittner stated that they continue to have that reputation due to the renters of the properties. She thanked the Village for passing the rental and nuisances ordinances. Ms. Bittner stated that her property value had double since the time she purchased her property in 1995 stating that when she purchased the property was purchased at 55,000.00 and now the value is 105,000.00.

Ms, Bittner stated that she has witnessed police visits to a particular property up to 8 times in one day.

Mayor Irwin stated that she was confident the board would pass the ordinances. Mayor Irwin stated that she appreciated the help the Village received from her homeowner association.

- II. PUBLIC HEARING – ANNEXATION, Carl and Julie Ann Cox, 27313 W. Longwood Dr**

Attorney Teegen stated that he was in receipt of the original certificate of publication and affidavits of mailing which would give the Village jurisdiction to proceed on the hearing of annexation agreement. Mayor Irwin closed the Public Hearing.

III. PUBLIC HEARING - COMPREHENSIVE PLAN – Portion of Sayles Property

Attorney Teegen stated this was related to the comprehensive plan relating to a small section of the Sayles Property being residential which was amended a few years back and is now being amended again. Attorney Teegen asked the Board Members if they had any questions and opened the meeting to audience comments. Mayor Irwin closed the Public Hearing.

IV. PRESENTATION- Fox Lake Lifestyle Development Group – Mike Stessman and George Reese

Mike Stessman introduced himself and George Reese. Mike Stessman stated that this was not a presentation but more of an update to the development plans and a request. Mr. Stessman stated that the property purchased was closed on and was no longer the Sayles property.

Mr. Stessman stated that the site plans were in the finalization and the arborist study was complete and they were prepared to clear the trees.

Mr. Stessman stated that permits were in place and the contractor would be hired June 27, 2006 to begin work.

Mr. Stessman stated his request would like to begin work immediately while they worked through the P.U.D. process and have the occupancy for the dry stack storage is set upon the approval of the P.U.D. Mr. Stessman stated they were asking to begin work but if they begin work began and the P.U.D. was not approved then they would not receive occupancy into the storage.

Mr. Stessman stated that they were under some tight time deadlines and would like to have this completed by October.

Mr. Hart stated from the beginning of these conversations about the dry stack storage it was improper zoning because it was being built in B4 zoning instead of B5.

Mr. Hart stated that there were three options for this development one being start the re-zoning process, start the P.U.D. process or ask for permission to start building process and not be given occupancy until the P.U.D, was approved.

Mr. Hart stated the intent was to start the P.U.D. started and provisions would be needed to remove the building which would all be part of the building process and to get things in place for the TIFF district.

Attorney Teegen asked Mr. Hart about the Architectural Review and Trustee Working asked about a Site Plan.

Mr. Hart stated he looked at the site plan and the building will be next to the Ford Dealership and he was given preliminary plans to review but they were adding to the plan.

Mr. Hart stated that the plans were not just a plain building but there were brick accents. Mr. Hart stated there were plans for an attractive building.

Trustee Working stated that he believed it should be passed by the Architectural Review and Attorney Teegen agreed also stating that it would be at the risk of the developer in the event that the construction would not be approved.

Mayor Irwin asked Mr. Stessman if he was in agreement with these terms. Mr. Stessman agreed and stated there intent agreed to perform in all phases and would comply.

Mr. Stessman stated his intent was to comply and they were on tight time frame with the dry stack storage with a Holiday Inn approval following on July 10, 2007 and Inplay following staying within the agreement with the development agreement and within the TIF structure moving forward.

Mr. Stessman stated that this would be the main entry and would need to be inviting to those who would visit and would need to look very good and they would not build a structure that was not visually appealing.

Trustee Koske stated the Architectural Review Board would meet on July 17, 2007 and asked if the developers would be prepared at that time.

Mr. Stessman stated that they would be prepared.
