III. Discussion

Petition for Sign Variance at 13 East Grand Avenue

Petitioner, Ron Stochl, owner of 13 E. Grand Ave. is requesting Planning & Zoning Commission's consideration to allow for the installation of a backlit primary wall sign with an opaque background.

Owner of The American Dream Mattress Store Robert Clarke apologized to the Planning & Zoning Board stating he was only made aware of the meeting 30 minutes prior. Mr. Clarke said he is not familiar with the Village's Sign Ordinance; he just wants to get a sign up on the building. The owner of the building will be paying for the sign and Mr. Clarke will be paying for the vinyl lettering.

Based on the discussion and feedback from the Planning and Zoning Board, Community Development Director Donovan Day stated it would be inappropriate to have a backlit sign in the Downtown Zoning District with the sign ordinance that is currently in place. Commissioner Warden agreed.

Commissioner Foster addressed the Fox Lake Sign Ordinance and the intent for the Downtown Zoning District was to create signage that projects a historic type of look that complements the historic look of the downtown. Internally lit (backlit) primary wall signs are not permitted.

Robert Clarke agreed with the intent of the Fox Lake Sign Ordinance. Mr. Clarke stated he wasn't opposed to any ideas for signage and welcomed all suggestions. Director Day suggested that adding gooseneck lighting and removing the backlit would meet the regulations for the downtown. Commissioner Fenneman agreed.

Commissioner Schultz made a motion to approve the petitioners request for a sign variance at 13 East Grand Avenue, Seconded by Commissioner Vander Weit.

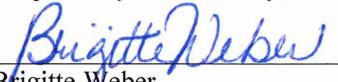
