**1) 152 Eagle Point Rd – Variance**

## 2) 156 Eagle Point Rd – Special Use Permit to Operate a Short-term Rental

Sandy Arneson was sworn in.

The main goal is to have a short-term rental for families for 2 to 7 days. Ms. Arneson stated that all village guidelines will be followed. The property will not be rented for parties, weddings, conferences or other types of events (according to village rules). This will be the first short-term rental for Ms. Arneson. Ms. Arneson her daughter will work together to manage the property. There was discussion regarding parking availability and that the parking area must have an impervious surface. Also, the property is on a well for water and has city sewer.

Several suggestions to make the petition more complete were presented by the commissioners and Chairman Gauger suggested that Ms. Arneson confer with the Director of the Community Development (Jodi Luka) and others in the Building Department to expand on the information in the petition packet before the future Village Board meeting where her petition will be considered.

All six condition questions were asked and answered.

### Audience Comments

Michele Kudelas was sworn in.

Ms. Kudelas stated that her main concerns are strangers, crime, and safety in the neighborhood. She is also concerned about noise, the cohesion of the neighborhood and uncontrolled garbage. She also noted that STR properties help to create a shortage of housing in the area for people looking for a full-time residence.

### Motion of Recommendation

Commissioner Bongiovanni made a motion to approve the Special Use Permit for a Short-term Rental as presented, for the property commonly known as 156 Eagle Point Road (Fox Lake, IL) in accordance with Village of Fox Lake Zoning Code 9-1-6-10, subsection C. By ordinance, six standards need to be satisfied; they are 1, 2, 3, 4 5, and 6. There is one additional condition: parking for only 4 vehicles in the driveway. This was seconded by Commissioner Bell.

3) 282 E Grand Ave – Sign Variance

Commissioner Nakanishi made a motion to approve the sign variation petition, as presented, for the property commonly known as 282 E Grand Avenue, Fox Lake, Il. The specific variations are: ordinance10-1-2, increase the allowed height of this sign by 5’7” over the ordinance height of 10 foot; ordinance 10-01-6-d, to allow an EMC to be mounted on poles in as well as having this EMC to be an accessory to a sign type other than the permitted monument sign; and ordinance 10-1-8-b, permits pole sign with integrated LED message screen on Grand Avenue.
