At the Board of Police and Fire Commission Meeting, held at the above address in Lake County Illinois on August 7th, 2024, the meeting was called to order at 5:02 pm by Board Commissioner Kenney. The following official business was transacted:

III. Approval of previous Meeting Minutes:

Commissioner Moore made a motion to approve the minutes for 6/4/2024, Commissioner Kenney seconded the motion, all were in favor.

V. Unfinished Business:

- a. Chief DeServi updated the Board as to the status of the two remaining candidates on our current eligibility list. One has been hired elsewhere and the other has withdrawn from consideration.
- b. Chief DeServi informed the Board that the recruit that was hired as a CSO was unable to pass the POWER test prior to the start of academy and has withdrawn from consideration for the Patrol Officer position.
- c. Chief DeServi notified the Board that the Command staff interviewed the lateral applicant that was previously interested. Chief DeServi advised that she will be doing a ride along so that she can better understand our community and Officers. A decision will be made after the completion of the ride along.
- d. Chief DeServi explained to the Board that the 2 Officers that were on FTO have been released from FTO and are doing well.
- e. Chief DeServi announced that the three recruits in the academy have recovered from their injuries and are set to graduate next week.
- f. Attorney John Kelly provided documentation of the requested change to the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Commissioner Kenney motioned to

approve the changes to the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Commissioner Moore seconded, all were in favor. The Rules and Regulations will be signed at the next meeting and published shortly thereafter.

VI. New Business:

- a. Chief DeServi requested permanent status for Officer Salgado, for her successful completion of her 18 month probation period. Officer Salgado's permanent status was approved by the Board.
- b. Chief DeServi requested that Board of Commissioners allow the Department to re-open the testing process, due to the exhaustion of the current eligibility list. The Commission approved Chief DeServi's request to re-open testing, with a closing date to be determined at the next Commission meeting.
