Well No. 9

Construction of Well No. 9 in the Village of Fox Lake was financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The project includes drilling a new well - Well No. 9 - within the Village of Fox Lake. Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in Fox Lake by replacing an existing well contaminated with per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances – known as PFAS. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
