Lead Service Line Replacement Phase 2

Construction of the Lead Service Line Replacement Program, Phase 2 in the Village of Fox Lake was financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The project includes the replacement of approximately 200 lead water service lines at various locations within the Village of Fox Lake. Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in Fox Lake by removing a possible source of lead in drinking water. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
